 - Limited access management (i.e. Highway 123)
 - Overlay district and corridors: individual community characteristics, but general consistency as you move through the region
 - Public private partnerships
 - Mixed use housing
 - Pedestrian signals/crossing as part of transit
 - Sewer expansion
