

Child Well-Being Network: Health Workgroup Meeting Notes
Wednesday, January 13, 2016

- **Attendees identified opportunities for improvement and key issues being faced regarding children's health.** Topics discussed during the meeting included:
 - Mental health – access to professional, gaps in treatment availability due to age or condition
 - Lack of awareness for existing programs
 - Poor referral network that makes it difficult for clients to navigate the services available to them
 - Lack of transportation to get to appointments and service providers
 - Universal screening – many children are never screened for developmental disabilities and are therefore never treated
 - Obesity – getting information to parents about preventing obesity, access to healthy food, lack of physical activity, creating sustainable programs in communities by building on existing obesity prevention programs

Next Steps:

- **Submit recommendations for successful obesity programs to learn about at our next meeting.** Some recommendations given during the meeting included: New Impact, LiveWell Greenville, and Eat Smart Move More SC.
