- **Updates on successful local food initiatives in the Upstate:**
 - **Hub City Co-op**, Garland McQueen, General Manager: Hub City Co-op is the first cooperative grocery store in the Upstate. The co-op features many local food and artisan items and serves downtown Spartanburg.
 - **Uptown Market**, Stephanie Turner, Market Manager: The Uptown Market is a focal point of downtown Greenwood and features a covered pavilion and houses the farmer's market.
 - **Feed & Seed**, Mike McGirr, Founder: Feed & Seed is continuing to make partnerships in the Upstate to help increase access to local, healthy foods, as well as assisting producers in selling more product.
- **Attendees discussed several opportunities for improvement within the Upstate's local food system:**
 - The Upstate needs skilled food service labor. This is an opportunity for technical schools to offer a certificate program.
 - A new processing facility, Back 40 Butchery, will be opening in Abbeville County. In order to keep up with producers' demands, another processing facility is still needed in the Upstate.
 - The Upstate needs organic and USDA certified processing facilities.
