- **Opportunities for collaboration to improve the health of children in the Upstate:**
 - The Bradshaw Institute is a model that could be replicated statewide and nationally.
 - Push for developmental screenings for all children in our region.
 - Some families need assistance, but aren't asking or looking for it. There might be a process for reaching those families.
 - Increase in a two generational approach to care, where organizations are treating children and their parents, creating better outcomes for the entire family.
 - Opportunity for expansion of care coordination in Greenville. The concept was valued by the Riley Institute at Furman and could be used as a model.
