- **The Leadership Team has decided to cancel Housing Workgroup meetings indefinitely.** The Housing Workgroup hosted several successful meetings and identified several opportunities for collaboration, however at this time many organizations, municipalities, and counties are working on this issues. Ten at the Top has committed to convening a Housing Committee in the future if deemed necessary and beneficial.
