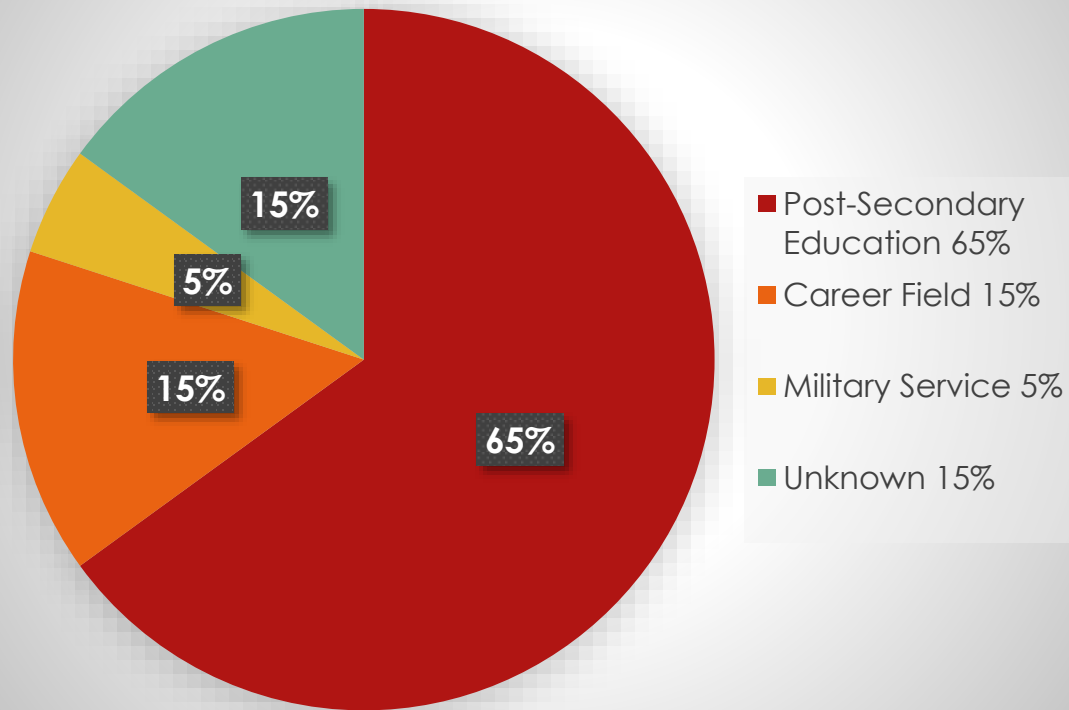

 - ▶ English Achievement: 110% of Goal
 - ▶ Math Achievement: 101% Of Goal
 - ▶ Technical Skills Achievement: 109% of Goal
 - ▶ School Completion: 101% of Goal
 - ▶ Student Graduation: 113% of Goal
 - ▶ Student Placement: 101% of Goal
 - ▶ Non Traditional Participation: 182% of Goal
