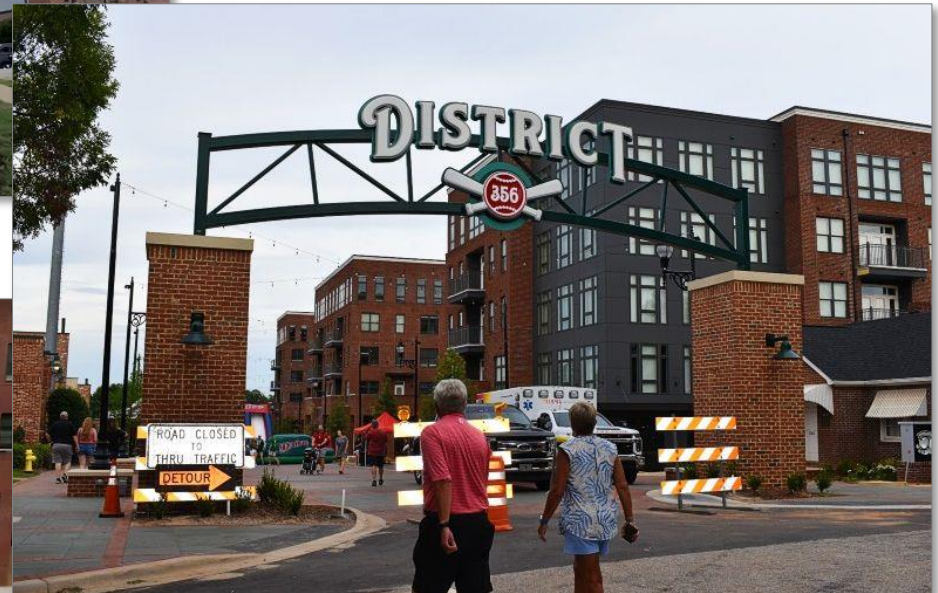

PROGRAM INNOVATION

By supporting diverse, underserved, and isolated communities, the YMCA of Greenville is committed to offering programs that respond to the community's most pressing needs. RECESS is a direct reflection of this commitment and provides an opportunity for inclusiveness and cultural relevancy. Program benefits often extend beyond the target population and can be a powerful opportunity to build cross-cultural awareness and understanding by bringing together diverse groups.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Recreation Exercise Community Education Service Social serves adults with diverse abilities by providing opportunities to socialize with peers, promoting healthy lifestyle habits through proper nutrition and exercise, fostering community involvement, independent living and social skills and service. YMCA of Greenville recognizes that for many adults, the end of high school means the end of social, educational and recreational opportunities in a structured environment; and there is a need for a place for adults with diverse abilities to find acceptance, belonging and opportunities for a better lifestyle.

KEY TAKEAWAY

In Greenville, there are limited opportunities for day programming for adults with diverse abilities. While many of these individuals require care, they are also very active and social, qualities that are often inhibited in adult day care services and long term home care. RECESS is one of only two organizations in Greenville that provide day programming for adults with disabilities. After growing from five participants to 70, the Y strives to see that RECESS continues to make a positive impact on participants as well as the community.

JOB COACHING

At the Y, we believe people of all ability levels should have the opportunity to reach their full potential. To support individuals with diverse abilities in their search for employment, RECESS designed a unique job coaching program that encourages participants to build job skills with the aid of a job coach. Since its inception in the Spring of 2021, three participants have completed the program and are independently volunteering within their community, and three participants have obtained gainful employment.
